Ravel & Stitch exemplifies the story of wine in the Central Coast and why this is a great growing region. Ravel, meaning bringing things together, is the knotting of different cultures of the early pioneers who, with their untamed spirit, came together to build a new community. Stitch, is the blending of sites, grapes, and winemaking techniques to create an exceptional wine with unique flavor and intensity.

VINEYARD

Our Ravel & Stitch Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from premier vineyards in the Central Coast appellation. Through careful selection of vineyards that offer a variety of soils, rootstocks, clonal material, and slopes we are able to create a beautiful wine that highlights the unique microclimate of each site.

TASTING NOTES

Lusciously complex.

Our Cabernet Sauvignon reflects the same bold spirit shared with those who pioneered the Central Coast growing region. The wine draws you in through the inviting aromatics of dark cherry and vanilla notes. The evolving flavors on the palate of dark fruits, such as olallieberry, are met by a rich lusciousness that hits on the middle of the palate.

Initially, individual lots from grapes stitched from each vineyard were fermented separately in stainless steel tanks and pumped over gently each day. The lots were then integrated into a final blend that was aged for 12 months in a combination of new and used French and American oak to produce a **luscious, layered, and rich** Cabernet Sauvignon.
